The Rally Cross will be held under the General Competition rules (GCR) of the Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS), the current CARS Rally Cross Regulations, and the Rally Cross Regulations of Bluenose Autosport Club (BAC) and these Supplementary Regulations. See bluenoseautosport.ca for RallyCross general competition rules (GCR), Online Registration and other information.

Each Rally Cross event will count as one round towards the BAC Rally Cross Championship.

Registration and payment must be completed on-line prior to 12 PM Saturday previous to each event. Each entrant is to fill out an <u>Online Registration Form for EVERY EVENT</u>.

Payments of **\$30** per driver is available by e-transfer to <u>treasurer@bluenoseautosport.ca</u>. Please use password BAC2021, with the security question Not containing BAC or 2021. Please include in the e-transfer what the payment is for, Thanks!

In the event of a cancellation, entry fees will be used as a credit towards a future event.

There will be a maximum of 60 competitors per event.

Description: Check In and Waiver signing will be in the red Registration building by the gate. Course location is in the back 40 (back parking lot). Trailer and Competitor parking on the left infield. Overflow parking by the tunnel.

Competitors will be our course workers at each event. A swap of positions can easily be done between runs.

Covid-19:

Based on current Nova Scotia COVID protocols, (<u>novascotia.ca/coronavirus/</u>) all participants, crew, and volunteers must show proof of vaccination and one piece of government issued ID during the Check-in process. All persons aged 12 or over must be fully vaccinated (had your second shot at least 14 days prior to the event).

Where possible Check-in will occur at entry to the site. If a volunteer is not available at the entrance when you arrive, please find the registrar to check in. While masking is not mandatory as this is an outdoor event, face coverings are recommended at Check-In and Timing & Scoring, at Drivers Meeting, during Course Walk and whenever 6 feet social distancing cannot be adhered to.

For multiple driver vehicles outside of your social bubble, it is recommended that wear full face helmets or face covering (ie: mask, balaclava) and gloves.

Passengers should wear face coverings.

Volunteer positions:

Starter: needs to see the Timer person for OK to start, then count down the cars "3, 2, 1!". Pylon runners, 4-5 positions available. For the field we need someone at the Top, Middle, Left, Right, and Bottom. When you see a pylon knocked down, put it back up! Indicate to the Timing & Scoring team for each pylon knocked down.

Please be on your best behaviour while on this property. <u>No drugs or alcohol to be consumed while on the premises.</u> Thank you for your cooperation.

Notes:

No open header exhausts will be permitted.

New this year, as per CARS bulletin, passengers must meet the following requirements:

- At least 16 years of age
- At least 80 lbs

- At least 4' 9" tall

It is recommended that all competitors have and use a spill kit, consisting of 2 absorbent pads, 1 hydrocarbon sock, and a heavy duty, resealable bag to contain them.

Competitors will need to provide on Rally day:

- MUST BE A MEMBER OF AN ATLANTIC REGION MOTORSPORT CLUB. Club memberships will not be available on site.
- driver's licence
- vehicle registration (if the vehicle is road licenced).
- proof of COVID vaccination (second shot received at least 14 days prior to event) and one piece of government issued ID
- if the owner of the vehicle is not listed as the driver or passenger, a written authorization from the owner of the vehicle is required.
- for any participant under the age of majority (i.e. 19), a written permission signed by a parent or guardian.
- **No part of this event will take place on public roads, so your car does not need to be street licenced or insured**
- **Bring your own helmet. There will be no loaner helmets available.**
