

Bluenose Autosport Club Race GCR's

Last Revised October 26, 2020

Club Championship

The Bluenose Autosport Club (BAC) Club level Race Championship shall be open only to full members of BAC-and its subsidiary organizations.

The club championship will consist of one overall trophy and awards for a separate class a separate sedan (closed wheel) and formula (open wheeled) championship, when applicable.

Club Championship Events

- 1. Qualifying events shall include all events scheduled on the Atlantic Region Motor Sports (ARMS) Regional Race Calendar.
- 2. The total point score for an individual shall be calculated using these criteria:
 - 1. The maximum number of events a competitor may count shall be the total number of events run less one.
 - 2. Points shall be scored in a competitor's class race only.
 - 3. If multiple races are run on a race day, each competitor will count his best finish in any one race.
 - 4. Competitors shall be scored based on their position relative to other BAC members only.

Scrutineering / Technical Inspection

Technical inspection as per ARMS regulations will be performed at all BAC races, with safety and legality of vehicles being the prime considerations.

The Chief Scrutineer will have authority to exclude from racing on these grounds.

Ties

Ties will be broken for championship awards only, with position determined by counting the number of first place finishes, then second place finishes, and so on until a winner is determined. If this fails to break a tie, it shall be considered tied for the position.

Subsequent positions will be awarded based on the number of competitors ahead.

Scoring

1 st	10 points
2 nd	6 points
3 rd	4 points
4 th	3 points
5 th	2 points
6 th , 7 th , 8 th , etc	1 point

For clarification:

-A competitor will only be awarded points for finishing position in the race for which the car is designed.

I.e. Either a GTA or GTB race or another contested class race one of the SM races will count points for this club championship.

-B.A.C. members will be awarded positions based on other club members only.

I.e.: A competitor finishes third at a race at AMP, but the 1st and 2nd drivers in the race are not BAC members. The competitor will count 1st place points for the purposes of this club championship.
