Subject: RallySafe for the Canadian Rally Championship

Issue Date: January 24, 2022

Effective Date: Immediately

The Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS) will implement the use of the RallySafe systems to all national events in the Canadian Rally Championship (CRC). Competitor feedback has been overwhelmingly positive and confirmed the benefits of the system.

All CRC events will be using the RallySafe system for timing, scoring data and tracking at all National Championship events. The RallySafe clocks on the units are considered the official time for the events. The event timing and scoring will be done using the times recorded by RallySafe. Events may also begin using the virtual chicane and other options available from RallySafe.

RallySafe costs will be managed by CARS in a cost neutral account, and charged to the events on a per car basis, at a flat rate/car that covers the cost of the RallySafe unit rental, timing and scoring data, tablets and logistics.

A further bulletin with the relevant rule changes will be issued in the near future.

Regional events are not required to use RallySafe, however, they have the following options available for use;

1. Full use of RallySafe including timing, scoring and tracking,
2. Partial use of RallySafe including tracking (timing and scoring done using system of organizer choice),
3. Use of a RallySafe Lite app that operates off of GSM service,
4. No use of RallySafe (organizer uses system of choice, may involve use of EZTrak, other tracking system or no tracking at all).

RallySafe User Information

All competitors participating in an event that will be using RallySafe, are required to review the RallySafe User manual and video tutorial, to become familiar with the system.

RallySafe Fitting Kits and Installation Requirements

All competitors participating in an event that will be using RallySafe will be required to purchase and pre-install a RallySafe Permanent Installation Kit from the RallySafe Store. This is a one-time purchase and install that stays with the car.

The RallySafe fitting kit must be installed before the RallySafe unit is installed at scrutineering. Cars not meeting this requirement will not pass scrutineering.

RallySafe Fitting Kit Manual

A few key points to keep in mind when installing the fitting kit;

- Ideally the fitting kit and unit mounting location should be in the center of the car, visible and accessible to both the driver and co-driver. Most of the time however; the kit is mounted on roll cage at the Co-Driver A-Pillar.
- The plugs must be able to reach level with the dash at the location of the mounting device, plus six inches.

Return of RallySafe Units

For cars completing an event, teams must remove the RallySafe unit immediately after checking into the finish control and return all items to the RallySafe/CARS representative on site.

For cars that DNF before the finish, teams must remove the RallySafe unit as soon as possible and return it to the RallySafe/CARS representative.

The competitor is responsible to return the RallySafe unit as they cost approx. \$2000. The competitor will be charged if the RallySafe unit is not returned.
