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Introduction:

Authority:

The Ledwidge Lookoff Regional Rally 2024 will be held under the Rally General Competition Rules of the Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS), the current rally Regulations and the current Bluenose Autosport Club (BAC) Rally Regulations, including all bulletins issued and in effect during the course of the event.

Modifications, amendments and/or changes to the Supplementary Regulations or the timetable will be announced by numbered, dated and approved bulletins by the race director and by a sports commissioner.

Road Surface:

The stages will be run on closed gravel and dirt forestry roads of Ledwidge Lumber in Tennycape NS. The stages are mostly single lane in width with varied surfaces, ranging from smooth gravel to packed soil.

Distances:

The entire event will be approximately 70.6 km of stage.

Transits will cover roughly 7.1 km on private dirt roads.

RallySprint competitors will have approximately 30 km of stage.

Fuel

Refueling procedure:

There will one service location, outside of HQ at Tennycape hangar. The Service area opens at 7h30 and closes at 20h00, on both days (June 1^{st} and June 2^{nd}).

Each team must use a plastic tarp the size of the rally car underneath the rally car during service. Should one not be placed, a penalty will be issued at the organizer's discretion. All Service Crews must have at least one fire extinguisher with a minimum UL rating of 40BC or 2-20BC in their respective service area. The fire extinguisher shall be easily accessible and in an area visible to anyone within the teams' respective service spot.

There will be only one re-fueling area located at the service area. Re-fueling may only take place when the re-fueling area is open. These times will be indicated in the Official Route Book and the Service books. Refueling at other locations during the rally shall be deemed to be illegal service and may be penalized according to NRR VII.C. NOTE: Refueling of any vehicle is not permitted in the service area.

Reconnaissance

Date:

Saturday, June 1, 2024

Entry Procedure:

Specific Directives:

Please review NNR's 13.6 Reconnaissance.

Two pass recce will be available on Saturday June 1st for all stages. This is following techinspection. Certain areas of the stages are used in both directions. Recce with caution. Rally cars may be used for recce.

While on the stage roads, the following conditions will be penalized:

- Reversing
- Exceeding maximum recce speed of 60kph or less if otherwise indicated (remember these roads are open to other traffic; there will be two-way rally traffic).
- The maximum speed on transit roads shall 60kph or the posted limit. Driving without due consideration for other road users (you may encounter residents, rally volunteers or forestrytruck drivers)
- Taking additional passes

Competitors guilty of any of the above will be assessed the penalties as per CARS GCR 7.4. Any rally competitors found on the stage roads outside the official reconnaissance time (within 60 days prior to the event) will be deemed to be practicing and as such will be subject to the usual CARS sanctions and will be excluded from the event (see CARS NRRs 17.8.1).

All competitors must check in by noon on Saturday, June 1st and by 9:00 am on Sunday, June 2nd.

Technical Inspection:

Schedule and Location:

7:30 - noon on Saturday, June 1st

Or

8:00 – 9:00 on Sunday, June 2nd

Items Required:

Competitors must present their logbook, proof of confirmed Registration, and Technical Inspection Self-Declaration (https://carsrally.ca/wp-content/uploads/2015/09/Registration-and-Technical-Inspection-Self-Dec digital.pdf) in order to enter technical inspection. Log books will not be issued/available at the event. Log books can be obtained from the CARS regional directors(CARS GCR&R 12.9).

Driver's Safety Equipment:

Inspection of personal equipment (Helmet, HANS, etc.) will take place Saturday, June 1st, at the time of tech inspection.

Special Regional Requirements:

The Scrutineer may inspect any competing vehicle at any time during the event to ensure vehicle eligibility and safety. A time allowance may be provided to facilitate this inspection. In the event that an infraction is found, the event Stewards will be notified.

The official Time Clock will be posted at HQ.

Ceremonial Start Procedure and Order:

Finish Procedure:

Go to Park Ferme.

Complete competitor feedback questionnaire.

Be prepared to move car to the podium area if in the top 3 overall.

Control Procedure:

RallyScoring Timing will be used for the rally (see CARS GCR&R 15.5). We will NOT be using an electronic timing system. Please review CARS GCR&R 17.9 for the appropriate use of Safety Warning Devices. All officials of the event (including marshals, radio personnel, traffic control, etc.) shall be deemed judges of fact and as such may point out any infraction of the Rally Rules and Regulations to the Organizer.

Restarts:

Please review CARS GCR&R 15.15 for details on the "restart after retirement" procedure. There will be no exceptions to these rules so please read and understand them.

Other:

The Drivers meeting is mandatory. The driver **AND co-driver of every team competing in the event must be present. Teams not represented at the meeting are subject to a fine of \$50.00. Roll call will be taken!

Competitors and Crews are reminded that the consumption of alcoholic beverages before the end of any day's competition activities at an event is forbidden (CARS GCR&R 5.11).

Podiums and prizes:

Top three overall finisher cars should be brought to the podium location after the event for awards and photographs.

Trophies will be awarded to overall 1st, 2nd and 3rd place of 4WD; 1st 2WD (if applicable); and 1st RallySprint (if applicable).

There is a single route, to be run in one direction three times (Leg 1: Pine Stages 1, 2 and 3) and to be run in the other direction three times (Leg 2: Spruce Stages 4, 5 and 6).


RallySprint competitors will run after the Rally competitors within each leg.
