

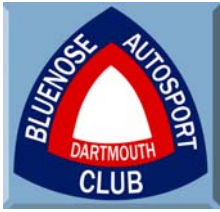

# Finish Time Control

## Roles & Tasks

*Controller of the Time Control. Note the time the team enters the zone.*

- Do not change tasks during a timed event.
- Choose the person who writes best to fill out the record sheet and the time card.
- Establish radio contact with the event manager and the start point. **Avoid talking unnecessarily.**
- Record the times on the record sheet and on the crew card. Please use the 24 hour clock.
- Never re-write over a number to correct. Always place a single line thru the bad number and write the good one next to it.
- Write very clearly. Always initial a correction.
- Count the number of vehicles that have passed through your control. Return documents to vehicle 99.
- Repeat the following steps as many times as your team is assigned to a timed event.
- When the number of people is insufficient, someone may have more than one responsibility.



### Controller 1 – Responsible for identifying when a team passes the finish line.

[Red]

- Be sure to identify a landmark to define the finish line.
- Make sure the FRS (home radio) is operating correctly (if being used).
- When a vehicle approaches, lift your arm.
- Blow the horn very loud when the vehicle crosses the finish line and then lower your arm.
- Never modify the timing of the finish during a timed event.
- Always be prepared to indicate the arrival of another vehicle.



### Controller 2 – Responsible for the Time Sheet.

[Red]

- When you hear the horn, write down the time: seconds, minutes and hour on the record sheet.
- Enter the car number, once confirmed by the controller 3.
- Record the time of arrival on the crew time card.
- Stay in radio contact with the event manager and start control.



### Controller 3- Responsible for the Time Card/Team.

[Red]

- Ask the crew for the time card.
- Return to Controller 2 to record the crossing time at the finish line.
- Once completed, hand over the time card to the crew.
- Record any misunderstandings with a crew in writing.
- Remove the vehicle from the control area as soon as possible.
